Counselors should make a list in duplicate and in alphabetical order of each person who is enrolling for a Gold Cup. List class, eg (JC I) and note whether this is a solo (S) or ensemble (E) composition. Leave the current year column blank. In the last column, list the fee paid for the student, or list "credit" if the student paid for Gold Cup last year and was not able to participate. One copy with the check (\$6.00 per entry), made payable to Pennsylvania Federation of Music Clubs, must be sent to the State Cup Chairman; and one copy should be retained for the clubs' records. This must be done by the stated deadline.

Entrants have the opportunity to work toward Gold Cups, with the first cup being earned with 15 points. Points for Junior Composers are as follows:

Superior – 8 points for a composition with 2 instruments or more (85-100 numerical score)

7 points for a composition with 1 instrument

Excellent – 6 points (Score 70-84) Satisfactory – 5 points (Score 55-69) Fair – 3 points (Score 40-54)

Needs Improvement – 1 point (Score 39 and below)
