

In 1968, along with her husband, Jim, Betty joined the Houston Symphony. While there she soloed with the orchestra, the Houston Ballet, and Galveston Civic Orchestra. After playing in Houston for 27 years, she retired from that orchestra and she and her husband settled in New Castle, Jim's home town. Although retired from orchestra work, Betty continues to play for various church venues and is an active board member of the Renova Music Festival held in New Castle the month of June. Betty plays a Ferdinando Garimberti modern Italian violin made in Milan, Italy, in 1923.


